


BLACK COMMUNITY CAMPING SNAPSHOT 2022 EDITION

Over the last decade, camping has become more representative of many diverse populations and communities of people. While diversity is increasing across many ethnicities, increases among Black campers have been among the most dramatic. Since 2017, Black camping households have increased 158%, from 3.1 million to 8 million in 2021. This growing subset of campers, 27% of whom were new to camping in 2021, are a dedicated group eager to explore. A full 46% take more than three camping trips a year and, as a whole, spent 7.4 nights camping in 2021.

In recognition of Black History Month, KOA celebrates the camping growth and behaviors within the Black community in our first Black Community Camping Snapshot.


